Teen Sewing Program June 2017  
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### Student/Parent Information

Welcome to the Teen Sewing Program at the Altadena Library! The students will be learning how to use a sewing machine to create fun projects. The class will be on six Saturdays from 10:00 - 12:00 from June 17 through July 22.

These are the projects the students will be sewing:

- June 17 - Drawstring bag
- June 24 - 9 Patch Pillow - embroidery optional
- July 1 - Skirt/shorts (student provides fabric for this project only)
- July 8 - Zipper bag
- July 15 - Monster
- July 22 - Complete unfinished projects. If all projects are complete, sew a flannel pillowcase.

The students will receive printed instructions for each project. The instructions are also on my teacher website at <http://lewisteach.com/> and you can see a picture of each project on the instructions. Often a project will not be completed in one session, and the student will finish the project on the following session.

If a student misses a class, s/he will skip the project for that week.

All the supplies are provided, except that the student will be selecting, purchasing, and bringing in the fabric for the skirt/shorts on July 1. Although not necessary, it is better to wash, dry, and iron the fabric before you sew it so the shrinkage has already happened. If you are unable to purchase fabric, let the teacher know and she will supply fabric, which is a cotton fabric with a black and white modern print.

The student will assemble a small sewing kit that s/he can bring home at the end of the program. It will contain pins, pin cushion, measuring tape, zipper clips, large safety pin, and embroidery needle.
